After experiencing sexual assault, fatherlessness, and depression, she went on to become the first in her family to graduate college, establish a successful purpose-driven career, and become a millionaire before the age of 35. Her writing, speaking, and teaching aims to provide the knowledge and expertise to intentionally tackle issues that impede progress toward belonging, inclusion, and personal fulfillment.

Murphy has over a decade of experience working with Wall Street firms to enhance their risk and diversity, equity & inclusion (DEI) strategies. She has developed and executed DEI strategies to support the hiring, retention, and advancement of underrepresented employees at Fortune 100 companies and designed dynamic educational programs to raise DEI awareness.

In 2020, Murphy published her debut book, *Home For Hurricanes*, a coming-of-age memoir in verse that honors the resilience of the human spirit as it explores issues of race, gender, sexual assault, parental abandonment, mental health, and faith. *Home For Hurricanes* was named a 2021 Best Book Awards Winner by American book Fest and became an Amazon bestseller.

Murphy is the founder and CEO of Literare Living LLC and co-owner of a real estate investment company she runs alongside her husband. They invest in underserved communities and rehabilitate properties to provide beautiful, affordable housing to low-income families.
